RE: Lance Armstrong vs. USADA and Travis Tygart

Dear Mr. Bock:

I write this letter in an attempt to confer. I have also placed a telephone call to do the same. In light of USADA's actions and professed deadline of July 14, 2012, Lance Armstrong has filed a Complaint in the United States District Court, Western District of Texas, Austin Division. (A copy has been emailed to you.) In conjunction with that filing, Mr. Armstrong seeks a Temporary Restraining Order and Preliminary Injunction. (A copy has been emailed to you.) I write to confer and inquire whether USADA will, without waving any rights, agree to a standstill consistent with the relief requested in the TRO and therefore obviate the need for the Court to rule on the motion and enter an order. We propose that the parties confer with the Court and then agree to a standstill of a reasonable period which will allow the parties and Court to address the matters raised in this case. Absent such an agreement, we must move forward with the request for temporary and preliminary relief.
