Dear Sean:

The deadline for Plaintiff's response to Defendants' Motion to Dismiss is today —14 days from the date we filed our motion. See Local Rule CV-7(e)(2).

In suggesting otherwise, I presume you have allotted yourself three additional days based on Rule 6(d) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. That rule does not apply here. Rule 6(d) adds 3 days when a party's deadline falls "within a specified time after <u>service</u>." (emphasis added).

Since Local Rule CV-7(e)(2) sets the deadline to respond to a motion based on the date of filing, not service, Rule 6(d) is inapplicable. See Local Rule CV-7(e)(2) ("A response to a dispositive motion shall be filed not later than 14 days after the filing of the motion."); see also Pavone v. Mississippi Riverboat Amusement Corp., 52 F.3d 560, 566 (5th Cir.1995) (concluding that the three-day extension in Rule 6 "applies only when a party is required to act within a prescribed period after service, not after filing") (emphasis in original).

We filed our motion well in advance of the deadline to answer so that it could be fully briefed prior to the hearing date set by the Court. Your planned untimely filing would greatly shorten the time we have to file a reply brief.

Accordingly, I would ask that you please file your response brief no later than the 5 pm close of business tomorrow - a day after your response was due.


Dear Tim and Sean,
