AFFIDAVIT OF SHAWN O. FARRELL

I, Shawn O. Farrell, under penalty of perjury, hereby declare and state as follows:

1. My name is Shawn O. Farrell. I am the Technical Director for USA Cycling and have been employed in that position since 2003. I am familiar with the International Olympic Committee's Olympic Charter; the Constitution, rules and regulations of the Union Cycliste Internationale ("UCI"), including the UCI's Anti-Doping Rules ("UCI ADR"); the World Anti-Doping Agency's ("WADA") WADA Code; the Bylaws of the United States Olympic Committee ("USOC"), and the Bylaws, rules and license applications of USA Cycling.

2. UCI is the international federation for cycling. The purposes of UCI, as set out in its Constitution, include "to direct, develop, regulate, control and discipline cycling under all forms worldwide." UCI Constitution, Art. I.2.a, at 1. A true and correct copy of the current version of the UCI Constitution is attached as Exhibit 22 to the Affidavit of Timothy J. Herman, Esq. (Doc. 45-1) ("Herman Aff.").¹ UCI is responsible for overseeing international cycling

competitions, including testing athletes for prohibited substances at international events that it sanctions.

3. The members of UCI are the national cycling federations around the world, including USA Cycling, which is recognized by UCI as the National Federation for cycling in the United States. USA Cycling is also recognized by the USOC as the National Governing Body for cycling in the United States.

4. UCI has a comprehensive set of anti-doping rules—the UCI ADR—by which its license-holders are bound. The current version of the UCI ADR is attached as Exhibit 23 to the Herman Aff.

5. Under the UCI ADR, UCI has exclusive jurisdiction over testing at those international events where it conducts testing (if UCI does not test at a particular international event, the National Federation in that country may test), and Doping Control for such matters is governed exclusively by the UCI ADR. *See Ex. 23 to Herman Aff. (current UCI ADR) at Arts. 2, 4, 202.* As defined by the ADR, “*Doping Control*” encompasses:

All steps and processes from test distribution planning through to ultimate disposition of any appeal including all steps and processes in between such as provision of whereabouts information, sample collection and handling, laboratory analysis, TUE’s, results management and hearings.

Id., Appendix 1, at p. 75.

6. Under the UCI ADR, UCI also conducts out-of-competition testing of its license-holders, and Doping Control for such testing is governed exclusively by the UCI ADR. *Id.*, Arts. 8, 202.

7. As a national federation for cycling, USA Cycling is bound by, and obligated to follow, UCI’s Constitution, rules, and regulations (including the UCI ADR) where applicable. *See Ex. 24 to Herman Aff. (current USA Cycling Bylaws) § K.4; Ex. 22 to Herman Aff. (current*

UCI Constitution), Art. II.6.1, at 2; Ex. 25 to Herman Aff. (excerpt from current Olympic Charter), Art. 29; Ex. 26 to Herman Aff. (excerpt from current USA Cycling Rule Book), at Rule 1B. Likewise, under the UCI Constitution, USA Cycling “shall have the Constitution, Regulations, and decisions of the UCI complied with by all persons concerned.” *See* Ex. 22 to Herman Aff. (current UCI Constitution), Art. II.6.1, at 2. The UCI Rule Book is a link posted on USA Cycling’s website at <http://www.usacycling.org/usa-cycling-rule-book.htm>.

8. Mr. Armstrong applied for and was issued several annual cycling licenses in classes that permitted him to race internationally in UCI sanctioned races.

9. Blank copies of those international cycling license applications that Mr. Armstrong would have signed for the years 2003–2005 and 2008–2011, which are referenced in my previous Affidavit (dated July 19th), are attached as Exhibits J–P to the Affidavit of Molly Tomlonovic (Doc. 33-6). I am also attaching as Exhibit 1 copies of hard copy documents regarding Mr. Armstrong’s license file that USA Cycling was able to locate during a preliminary review of its records prior to the Olympic Games, including a signed license application for Mr. Armstrong dated February 7, 2002.² Mr. Armstrong would have signed international license applications for years prior to 2002 as well, but we have not yet located any such documents in our non-exhaustive search of our files. Also attached, as Exhibit 2, is what I understand to be a copy of Mr. Armstrong’s international cycling license from 2010, which was provided to me by counsel for Mr. Armstrong.

² Please note that some of the signed license applications in Exhibit 1 are incomplete because that is how they were maintained in USA Cycling’s files. In addition, it appears that some forms were signed by Bill Stapleton on behalf of Mr. Armstrong.

10. The international license applications that Mr. Armstrong would have signed prior to 2004 did not refer to USADA.³

11. The Tour of Switzerland and the *Tour de France* are professional cycling events sanctioned by UCI and are part of the “UCI WorldTour.” See Ex. 27 to Herman Aff. (excerpts of UCI Cycling Regulations, Part 2: Road Races), at 2.1.001, 2.1.005, 2.15. UCI has exclusive authority over testing at these events when it chooses to engage in such testing. See Ex. 23 to Herman Aff. (current UCI ADR), Arts. 2, 4, 202.

12. The professional cycling teams on which Mr. Armstrong competed (*e.g.*, the United States Postal Service Team and the RadioShack team) were professional cycling teams that were licensed to compete in UCI World Tour events, including the Tour of Switzerland and *Tour de France*, as UCI ProTeams, the highest level team designation available under UCI’s rules. See, *e.g.*, Ex. 28 to Herman Aff. (printout from www.uciprotour.com listing RadioShack team as a UCI ProTeam); Ex. 27 to Herman Aff. (excerpts from UCI Cycling Regulations, Part 2: Road Races), at 2.15, § 4; Ex. 5 (excerpts from current UCI Rule Book) at Rule 1A24. UCI ProTeams are managed directly by the UCI. The events that Mr. Armstrong’s UCI ProTeams competed in, including the Tour of Switzerland and *Tour de France*, are not amateur athletic competitions or part of the Olympic, Paralympic, or Pan-American Games, or any world championship. USA Cycling does not designate which cyclists will compete for those UCI ProTeams or in the events in which they participate. Entrants in these races compete for professional teams, and not for their respective nations pursuant to the rules of such races. In

³ In my previous Affidavit of Shawn O. Farrell, dated July 19, 2012, I quoted language referencing USADA as being included in the 2003 and 2004 international license applications. See Affidavit of Shawn O. Farrell, ¶ 10. I reviewed the documents again, and the initial reference was incorrect: the language I quoted first appeared in the 2004 application. The international license application in 2003 did not refer to USADA.


addition, USA Cycling does not organize or sponsor cyclists to represent the United States in those professional cycling events, and USA Cycling does not conduct any selection process or tryout procedure for those competitions.

13. The “Medical Control” policy referenced in paragraph 13 of my earlier affidavit is an appendix to the USA Cycling Rule Book, which is separate from the USA Cycling Bylaws or Articles of Incorporation.

14. Floyd Landis was a UCI license-holder for a number of years, including 2010.


15. The foregoing statements are true and accurate to the best of my knowledge, information and belief.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY, INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE

I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT BY SIGNING THIS DOCUMENT, I AM ASSUMING RISKS, AND AGREEING TO INDEMNIFY, NOT TO SUE AND RELEASE FROM LIABILITY USA CYCLING, INC. (USAC), ITS ASSOCIATIONS (THE UNITED STATES CYCLING FEDERATION (USCF), NATIONAL OFF ROAD BICYCLE ASSOCIATION (NORBA), NATIONAL COLLEGIATE CYCLING ASSOCIATION (NCCA); U.S. PROFESSIONAL RACING ASSOCIATION (USPRO), AND BMX ASSOCIATION (BMXA)), AND USA CYCLING DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION (USACDF), AND THEIR RESPECTIVE AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, VOLUNTEERS, MEMBERS, SPONSORS, PROMOTERS AND AFFILIATES (COLLECTIVELY "RELEASEES"), AND THAT I AM GIVING UP SUBSTANTIAL LEGAL RIGHTS. THIS DOCUMENT IS A CONTRACT WITH LEGAL AND BINDING CONSEQUENCES. I HAVE READ IT CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING, AND I UNDERSTAND WHAT IT MEANS AND WHAT I AM AGREEING TO BY SIGNING.

In consideration of the issuance of a license to me by one or more of Releasees and being allowed to participate in an event permitted or sanctioned by USA Cycling, another national federation or International Cycling Union (UCI) (collectively "USA Cycling event") I hereby freely agree to and make the following contractual representations and agreements. **I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT CYCLING IS AN INHERENTLY DANGEROUS SPORT AND FULLY REALIZE THE DANGERS OF PARTICIPATING IN AN EVENT**, whether as a rider, official, coach, mechanic or otherwise, and **FULLY ASSUME THE RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH SUCH PARTICIPATION INCLUDING**, by way of example, and not limitation, dangers associated with man made and natural jumps, the dangers of collision with pedestrians, vehicles, other riders, and fixed or moving objects; the dangers arising from surface hazards, including pot holes, equipment failure, inadequate safety equipment, use of equipment or materials provided by the event organizer and others, **THE RELEASEES' OWN NEGLIGENCE**, the negligence of others and weather conditions; and the possibility of serious physical and/or mental trauma or injury, or death associated with events. For myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, assignees, and successors in interest (collectively "Successors") **I HEREBY WAIVE, RELEASE, DISCHARGE, HOLD HARMLESS, AND PROMISE TO INDEMNIFY AND NOT TO SUE** the Releasees and all sponsors, organizers, promoting organizations, property owners, law enforcement agencies, public entities, special districts and properties that are in any manner connected with a USA Cycling event, and their respective agents, officials, and employees through or by which the event will be held, (the foregoing are also collectively deemed to be Releasees), **FROM ANY AND ALL RIGHTS AND CLAIMS INCLUDING CLAIMS ARISING FROM THE RELEASEES' OWN NEGLIGENCE TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW**, which I have or which may hereafter accrue to me, and from any and all damages which may be sustained by me directly or indirectly in connection with, or arising out of, my participation in or association with a USA Cycling event, or travel to or return from a USA Cycling event, in which I may participate as a rider, team member, spectator, coach, mechanic, official, volunteer, or in any other manner. I agree it is my sole responsibility to be familiar with the course and agenda of a USA Cycling event, the Releasees' rules, and any special regulations for a USA Cycling event and agree to comply with all such rules and regulations, including, that I must submit to drug testing, if required. I understand and agree that situations may arise during a USA Cycling event which may be beyond the control of Releasees, and I must continually ride and otherwise participate so as to neither endanger myself nor others. I accept responsibility for the condition and adequacy of my equipment, any equipment provided for my use, and my conduct in connection with a USA Cycling event. I have no physical or medical condition which would endanger myself or others if I participate in a USA Cycling event, or would interfere with my ability to safely participate in a USA Cycling event. As a condition of my USAC license, I grant to USAC and USOC, and their assigns, the right to film, photograph, reproduce, publish and exploit my name, voice and any likenesses of me, and biographical material on me, but no such materials shall be used to endorse any product, service or sport other than bicycle racing.

I agree, for myself and my Successors, that the above representations are contractually binding, and are not mere recitals, and that should I or my Successors assert a claim contrary to what I have agreed to in this contract, the claiming party shall be liable for all expenses (including legal fees) incurred by Releasees in defending the claims. This contract may not be modified orally, and a waiver or modification of any provision shall not be construed as a waiver or modification of any other provision herein or as consent to any other waiver or modification. Every term and provision of this contract is intended to be severable. If any one or

Coach and Mechanic Certification Notice

USA Cycling certified coaches and mechanics are solely responsible for their own actions or failure to act in their respective roles; USA Cycling shall have no responsibility or obligation whatsoever for such acts or failure to act. Each USA Cycling certified coach and mechanic agrees as a condition of certification, to indemnify, hold harmless and defended USA Cycling and its employees, officers, directors, agents, sponsors and promoters from and against all claims and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees, that in a manner arise from or relate to a certification of the individual by USA Cycling and that are asserted against or incurred by any one or more of the foregoing indemnified parties as a result of or arising from the certified individuals actions or failure to act.

License Coverage Area

International License (Excludes BMX)

The normal USA Cycling International License is only valid for the Road, Track, Mountain Bike, and Cyclo-cross events sanctioned by USA Cycling, another country's national federation or the International Cycling Union (UCI) and is not valid for the cycling discipline of BMX. A separate International BMX License can be purchased from USA Cycling covering the cycling discipline of BMX.

International BMX License

The USA Cycling International BMX license is valid for BMX events only sanctioned by USA Cycling, another country's national federation or the International Cycling Union (UCI) and is not valid for other cycling disciplines such as Road, Track, Mountain Bike, Cyclo-cross or domestic BMX events (ie. ABA, NBL, etc) not sanctioned by USA Cycling. A separate International License can be purchased from USA Cycling covering the disciplines of Road, Track, Mountain Bike, and Cyclo-cross.

COMPETING OUTSIDE THE UNITED STATES

In addition to an International License, a rider must obtain a Foreign Permission Letter (FPL) for each country in which a rider wishes to race (some exceptions may apply for Canada and Mexico for residents of bordering states). To obtain a FPL, submit your license information along with the names of the countries you will compete in, dates you will be overseas, foreign teams of which you will be a member, and a foreign address if available. To request an application, call 719-866-4581 or visit our website. FPL's are free for the first ten (10). Additional letters are \$5.00 each. Please allow three weeks for processing. Additional fees may be incurred for requests involving express processing or mailing.

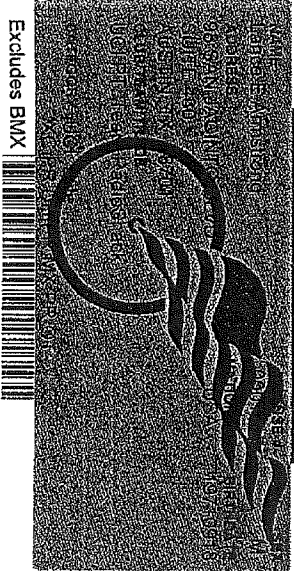
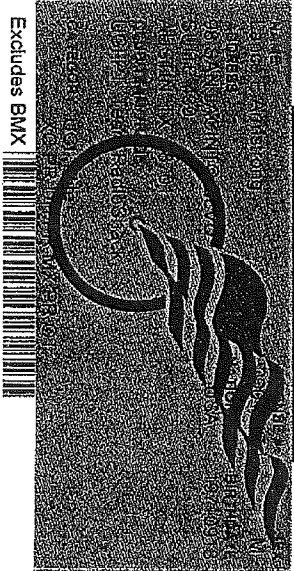
