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AFFIDAVIT OF JONATHAN VAUGHTERS

Before me this day personally appeared, Jonathan Vaughters, a person to me well known, who, upon his oath, stated as follows:


1. My name is Jonathan Vaughters. I am over the age of 21 and fully competent to state the facts in this affidavit. The facts are true and correct and within my personal knowledge.

2. I have seen a copy of what is claimed to be a text message between Frankie Andreu and me that occurred on or around July 28, 2005, attached as Exhibit 1. I recall participating in that text exchange. There may be more or different parts to the text exchange than are reflected in Exhibit 1, such as at the end of the session, but I cannot state that the document is complete. I believe, however, there may have been more to it.

3. The exchange was nothing more than, and I never intended it to be more than, an exchange of second or third hand gossip. I have no personal knowledge that any team in the Tour de France, including the Discovery Team in 2005, engaged in any prohibited conduct whatsoever. My exchange with Andreu was merely me gossiping about one of many issues that

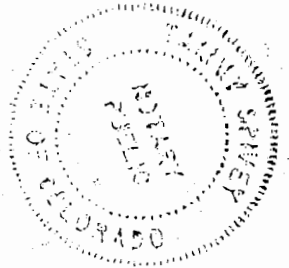
are bantered around about the Tour de France that vary in type and range. This text message concerns rumors and speculation about which I have no personal knowledge as to their truth or factual bases. My comments regarding teams or riders in the session are nothing more than rumors and speculation. If anyone were to characterize what I was discussing as factually based, or my opinion, that a characterization would be incorrect and unfair.


4. This was a private gossip session that I did not know was being recorded and did not intend to be public precisely because the information in it is unsubstantiated and, therefore, unreliable. I was never told the gossip session had been recorded and the Andreus never asked my permission to do so or to release it. I never intended anyone to take what I was saying and represent it as fact. I have had many other conversations discussing many issues, not the least of which is that riders and teams in the Tour can and certainly do win without the use of performance enhancing drugs or methods.
