NOTICE

Based upon the investigation reports submitted by the District Attorneys' Offices of Bologna and Ravenna, the District Attorney's Office in charge of Anti-doping has summoned Dr. Michele Ferrari to appear before the FCI (Italian Cycling Federation, N. of T.) Disciplinary Commission. The investigation reports revealed sufficient evidence of Dr. Ferrari's involvement in doping-related activities. The FCI, on behalf of the ICU, enforces the sanctions provided in article 158 of the current ICU Anti-Doping Regulations and specifically forbids:

- -Dr. Ferrari to become a member of any other national or international cycling Federation;
- -Dr. Ferrari to take part in any race or sport event of any kind organized by the FCI or the ICU.
- all Federations, clubs, sport societies and any other individual associated with the ICU to use the services of Dr. Ferrari.
